Toshiro TANAKA is Professor of European Political Integration, Jean Monnet Chair ad personam since 2003, Faculty of Law, Keio University. Director of Keio Institute of Law and Political Science since 2007 and Director of Keio Soccer Club since 1992. He has become Director of EU Studies Institute in Tokyo (EUSI: Hitotsubashi University, Keio University and Tsuda College) since December 2008.

He was educated at Department of Political Science, Faculty of Law and Graduate School of Law and Political Science, Keio University and became a member of faculty with tenure in 1971 and Professor in 1985. He spent many years in abroad including Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy (1973-75), University of Sussex (1979-80), Japanese Mission to the EC in Brussels (1985-87) and EUI (1993-94). He served as Vice-President of Keio University responsible for public, alumni and international relations (2001-05). He is a founding member of EUSA-Japan and was President (2002-04). He was also President of EUSA Asia-Pacific (2003-06). He was Director of Keio Jean Monnet Centre for EU Studies (2007-08).
